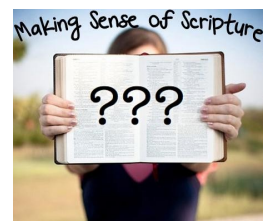

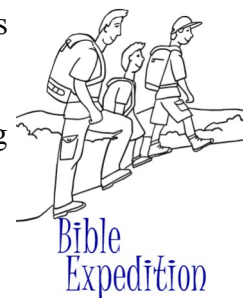
### Outreach Ministry
